





They were housed together in a large, metal warehouse in this small farming community that is home to one of north-central Iowa's most prolific canine dealers.

"One puppy was delivered to a suburban pet shop with her pedigree papers.

The other two — confirmed littermates — were declared "rescue dogs" and sold to a pet shop in Chicago. With that rescue label firmly attached to their cages, the store could sell the dogs for more than \$1,000 apiece and still be in compliance with a city ordinance that bans shops from offering commercially bred pets..."





In Massachusetts, dogs aren't allowed in for rescue without mandatory 48 hr. quarantine.

There is no such quarantine for "owned dogs". To get around this law, dogs often trucked outside state

borders and picked up at rest stops/hotels.












Red Flags



<u>Pro Tip</u>: If a rescue (or breeder) can't spell the name of the town they are fake-operating in, it might be indicative they aren't on the up-and-up.



<u>Pro Tip</u>: If the same dog is listed under many names, breeds, locations, it's not here.

First three: Poodle Rescue (Legit)



A MA animal shelter: Presentation at local school. Most kids said "I have a rescue dog. None acquired from shelter 2 miles from school. All acquired by driving to CT.





- Noise sensitive: Busiest street in city.
- "Want dog happy. Didn't expect to talk about drugs".
- "Good with kids"
- Elderly Couple



Rocky:

- 8 y/o Pomeranian from South Carolina.
- On PetFinder as "happy dog, completely vetted. Walks well on a leash and is ready to be your best friend!"
- Came off the truck with worms, collapsed trachea and pneumonia. No teeth.
 Spent over \$2,000 at emergency hospital 1st week.
- Shut down, anxious
- Belly Band peed on everything, including other dog
- Barked non stop
- Referred to Vet Behaviorist: more \$

Roxy's Story: Mix of Transport/Local Rescue

- Met in CT day before first of 4 snowstorms that crippled Boston.
- Dog in backseat with 8 year old child
- Dog was "scariest dog we ever had."
- Shiba Mix. Emotional weight.
- Multiple bites
- Afraid to fail dog.
- Increasingly common scenario.






Trigger Stacking: Stress Thresholds







What Can Trainers Do?

- Submit letters to CPDT, Karen Pryor, IAABC, VSA, etc. to give CEUs for implementing programs with shelters/rescues
- Donate your time: Educate & Volunteer (specifically socialization, stress, mental stim, target, body language)
- Help put together a handout of reputable resources in the area
- Teach stress signals/greetings/behavior assess in shelters / in rescues

How Can You Work Outside The Box?


- ACOs less \$ for local dogs?
- TNR? Sanctuary for unadoptable dogs?
- Report loophole rescues (BBB / Dog Merchants)
- Reach out to Petfinder /AAP to place TRULY local dogs first
- Socialization
 - Begins in utero: Pregnant dogs in foster ASAP
 - Window closes at 16 weeks
 - 6 month old dog isn't a puppy...it's a teenager

What Can Rescues/Shelters Do?

- Stop labeling breeds
- Fine?
- Transparent!
- Resources
- Follow up
- Report
- Partnership
- Connect with PF and AAP
- Not binary!
